## **HAVE YOU GOT THE RIGHT ID TO VOTE?**

**In order to vote, you MUST now bring a valid ID to the polling station. This is a new regulation. You can sign up to become a postal voter by Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April to avoid this.**

### **Examples of acceptable forms of ID:**

- Passport
- Older Person's Bus Pass
- Driving Licence
- Blue Badge
